**“Liquid applied Polyurethane Water Proofing”**

### **Abstract**

Water leakage from roof and other structures is a common concern in many residential and commercial buildings. Today there are various types of water proofing solutions available in the market viz. Bituminous coatings / membranes, Polymer modified cementitious coatings, Acrylic elastomeric liquid applied coatings etc. Though each of them has its own advantages, Polyurethane coatings due to its unique chemistry offers exceptional properties to the end users.

Unlike the traditionally used waterproofing systems like sheet membranes, liquid applied polyurethane coating application requires comparatively less skill and supervision. Polyurethane water proofing offers durable elasticity and strength in order to protect the structure from water ingress across a broad range of temperatures and other outdoor weathering elements such as wind, UV radiation and microbial attack.

The presentation will cover general approaches towards water proofing with special emphasis on polyurethane based water proofing solutions.
